Hoppin' for Health is a curriculum designed to reduce the fears that young children have about healthcare settings by increasing their understanding of body parts, common medical instruments and procedures, and the roles of medical professionals. The curriculum includes educational resources, tools, and activities that are easily downloaded, copied, and adapted to a wide variety of instructional settings, to leave children more curious and prone to ask questions about their health check-ups.
